SINGLES FREESKATE

Must not have passed any part of the Star 6 Freeskate Assessment

Skaters may be grouped by age. Refer to the Skate Canada Star Technical package for requirements.

Star 1 Element Assessment

Elements assessed to Standard

Star 2 Freeskate

One program of a maximum 2:10 minutes in length

Program is scored using assessed to standard

Star 3 Freeskate

One program of a maximum 2:00 minutes in length (+/- 10 seconds)

Program is scored using assessed to standard

Star 4 Freeskate

One program of a maximum 2:00 minutes in length (+/- 10 seconds)

Program is scored using assessed to standard with ranking

Three age categories may be used should numbers warrant: U10,

U13 and 13&O

DANCE EVENTS

PATTERN DANCE (Partnered)

Dance teams must be comprised of two skaters.

Dance events will be assessed to standard

Each skater must have passed the Star 1 Dance Assessment

Skate Canada Series 8 music will be used for all pattern dance events.

Skaters have the option to use a selection from the ISU Ice Dance music (only 1-5) or from the Skate Canada Approved List of Contemporary music.

If skaters choose to use either the ISU or Contemporary music selection, they must supply this music to the competition organizers.

Only Skate Canada Series 8 music will be used during the warm-up period.

STAR 2/STAR 3 DANCE PATTERN DANCE (Partnered Dance)

Dance # 1	Dutch Waltz	(2 sequences)
Dance # 2	Baby Blues	(2 sequences)

STAR 2/STAR 3 PATTERN DANCE (Solo)

Dutch Waltz (2 sequences)

SHOWCASE

Showcase Programs are designed by the skaters and/or coach and focus on skater's ability to entertain an audience through use of theatrics or artistic abilities. Programs may tell a story, create a mood or have an obvious theme. Costumes and props are permitted within the restrictions.

Programs will be assessed to Standard in three criteria within the two Program Components: Presentation and Skating Skills

Showcase 1

Skaters must have passed the Star 1 assessment in any discipline
One program maximum of 1:00 minutes in length

Showcase 2

Skaters must have passed a Star 4 assessment in any discipline
One program maximum of 1:30 minutes in length

Program content requirements:

- Theatrical costumes and hand props are permitted. **Feathers and boas of any type are not permitted.**
- Vocal music is permitted
- All single jumps are permitted. Jumps of any higher rotation will be subject to an illegal element violation if included

CREATIVE IMPROV

Creative Improv programs are designed only by the skater with minimal preparation. Creative Improv tests the skater's ability to quickly interpret a given piece of music and entertain the audience

There is **NO COACHING** permitted for these events.

Each program will be assessed in three criteria within the two Program Components: Presentation and Skating Skills

Creative Improv 1

Skaters must have passed the Star 1 assessment in any discipline.
Program maximum of 45 seconds in length

Creative Improv 2

Skaters must have passed a Star 4 assessment in any discipline.

Program maximum of 45 seconds in length

Program Content Requirements:

- A different music selection must be used for every event(group) so that no skater has the advantage or disadvantage of skating to music already used in competition
- All the skaters in a given group for an event are presented with a pre-selected piece of music by the Technical Representative prior to warm-up. All skaters in the group for that event will perform to the same musical selection.
- Skaters will listen to the music twice off the ice in a designated area (dressing room) and once on-ice during the warm-up period.
- Skaters are then kept in a sound-proof dressing room until it is their turn to perform
- Simple skating attire is required
- All single jumps are permitted. Jumps of any higher rotation will be subject to an illegal element violation if included

ELEMENTS

Star 2 Elements

Assessed to Standard

Elements to be performed are:

Single Loop jump

Waltz/Single toe Loop jump combination

Backward Upright Spin

Forward Spiral Sequence

STAR 3 ELEMENTS

Assessed to Standard

Elements to be performed are:

Single Flip jump

Single Loop/Single Loop jump combination

Combination Spin

Forward Spiral sequence

STAR 4 ELEMENTS

Assessed to Standard with Ranking

Elements to be performed are:

Single Axel

Single Lutz/Single Loop jump combination

Combination Spin

Forward Spiral sequence

Program Requirements:

- Each skater will perform 4 elements in isolation in the order listed for their level of competition
- Each element may only be attempted once
- All skaters will perform element 1, before performing element 2 and so on
- Star 2 to Star 4 events will use half-ice to perform their elements

REGISTRATION

Registration opens: Monday March 9th at 10:00am and will close Friday April 17th at 11:59pm

Late Entries will be charged an additional \$50.00 late fee. No entries will be accepted after April 24th at 10:00am.

Schedule will be posted no later than 5 days before the event.
